INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE AND INFORMATION GUIDE

Personal protective equipment. To guarantee the best possible protection and comfort, read these instructions carefully. Warning! This product is no substitute for the safe operation of a chainsaw and does not provide full protection. Carefully read all safety instructions applicable to your chainsaw. The gloves should be scrapped and not used again if the protective area on the left-hand glove or mitten has been damaged, washed or cleaned incorrectly, or altered from its original shape. Damaged outer material must be repaired immediately in order to prevent the protective material becoming damaged. In the event of a repair being carried out to the outer material, do not sew into the protective material, as this may reduce its protective ability. Adhesive must not be used when carrying out repairs, as it may affect the protective material and reduce its protective qualities. If the glove gets wet it may reduce the grip.

Chainsaw protective "glove" design A conforms with EN 420:2003+A1:2009, EN 388:2003, EN 381-7:1999 Type A (wash symbols)
Garment care symbols: Do not dry clean, Do not wash, Do not bleach, Do not tumble dry, Do not iron.

Sizes: In order to achieve maximum grip when operating a chainsaw, ensure you have selected the correct glove/mitten size.
