These gloves fulfil the fundamental prescriptions of the European Directive (89/686/EEC) concerning Personal Protection Equipment (PPE's). By means of type approval, this garment has been certified to the European standard EN 381 Part 7:1999 - Protective clothing for users of hand-held chain saws. Furthermore the glove complies with the norm EN 420 (1994).

  For maximum satisfaction, do not store the gloves when wet. Store it in its original packing (polyethylene bag). Storage of the gloves in a dark and dry place will prevent discoloration. Any complaints regarding colour changes will not be accepted.

- \*These chainsaw gloves are provided with pads constructed from several layers loose woven material, so that, when in contact with a moving chain, the threads are torn out and clog the chain saw drive mechanism.

  \*\*HOWEVER, no item of the glove will provide full protection, therefore never intentionally let the chain make contact with any part of this glove. Remember a chainsaw is a machine which should always be treated with extreme caution according to the instructions of the chainsaw supplier (use both hands!!!).

  \*\*Only wear gloves of a suitable size. Gloves which are either too loose or too tight will restrict the movements and will not provide the optimum level of protection.

  \*\*Only mear gloves of a suitable size. Gloves which are either too loose or too tight will restrict the movements and will not provide the optimum level of protection.

  \*\*When not in use, store the gloves in a well ventilated area away from extremes of temperature. If the gloves are wet, reshape it by hand and allow it to 'ry fully before placing it into storage.

  The protective material and area of coverage must not be altered. If the gloves are damaged it will no longer provide the optimum level of protection, and therefore should be replaced immediately. Damaged gloves should be immediately destroyed or marked to prevent them from being worn again. NEVER wear damaged gloves.
